

Hageman Ranch NORTH/EAST Where to Hunt and How to get there

Each way-point is a suggested hunting spot that has been determined by the owner to provide a good probability of seeing and taking big game. These hunting locations are a first-come first-serve basis so if someone is already in a specific spot there are plenty of others.

This rout takes the hunter from the Parking Lot around what we think of as the East side of the ranch. This area consists of open hay, scrub and sage areas that are lined with moderate to thick aspen and scrub forests. There are a number of good archery spots on the route and some good areas for longer distance rifle hunting.

Archery Spot NS Pass

This wonderfully isolated spot is perfect for the archer ... the spot allows you to look quite a way into a forest while watching a large expanse of open field. Many game cross here and especially walk the line between forest and field.



NE Field South

These fields are mainly the domain of deer ... a few elk come through these areas but usually we find deer. So if you are looking for your big buck, this might be the place where you might find one.



North Pond Trail Cam 2

This area provides water and lick for quite a range of big game animals. If you look around you will see the trail cam that monitors this area. We put it here for good reason ... why take pictures of weeds? There are plenty of places in this area that you can use to wait for your trophy to appear. Perhaps we will be able to record your shot!



Archery Spot N Fence E

This crossover spot allows the hunter early morning and evening opportunities to see deer and elk with a preponderance of the traffic being deer. There is plenty of cover so staying out of site is not difficult. Again be mindful of the wind direction. If it is from the South this is a good place, if from the North choose a spot that is further to the South.
