

# Hageman Ranch MIDDLE/NORTH Where to Hunt and How to get there

Each way-point is a suggested hunting spot that has been determined by the owner to provide a good probability of seeing and taking big game. These hunting locations are a first-come first-serve basis so if someone is already in a specific spot there are plenty of others.

## Under The Scrub

The cattle just love this place under the scrub trees next to the 5<sup>th</sup> wheel. They have a wonderful habit of eating all of the leaves and branches off of the first 3 or 4 feet of each scrub tree making for a wonderful place to get protection from the sun while remaining hidden with a wide range of viewing options. Not only do you get a wonderful view of the pond, but you are able to observe all of the trails leading to and away from it.





## Bench Overlook

This spot allows you to see what the person at the bench can't. The spot offers a panoramic view of the bench area and is adjacent to a very good game trail that leads from the water at the west pond to the restful shade and feed on the north side of the ranch. Good rifle position and is a good stepping off place to stalk if you are an archer.





## Lower Bench Overlook

The lower bench is similar to the last one ... gives the hunter a different perspective and allows for some adjustment of position based upon wind direction and sun. Better for archery here.





## Mid Field North Side, Mid Field South Side

These spots afford the rifle or archery hunter a wide expanse of territory to watch over. With wide hay fields to the east, south and west and a game crossing sage flat to the north these two spots allows both the archer and rifle hunter to quickly see game at a distance that helps insure that you will remain hidden. ## Sage Flats Game Crossover, Mid Field South Side

These spots afford the rifle or archery hunter a wide expanse of territory to watch over. The sage and scrub gives a lot of cover for the stealthy archer as well as good cover to just wait to see what pops out of the Forrest to the east or sage flat to the west and north.





## **Sage Flats Game Crossover, Sage Flat North Side, North Fields West Fork, NW Corner View, NW Corner Marker**

Depending upon wind direction hunters may wish to hunt either of these three positions. Many game cross by here on their way to water located near the “WC” marker or on their way back from it.

## North Fence North Field, North Fields West Fork, Great View North Fields

If you follow the North property fence line through a wonderful quaker forest that in of itself provides many places to watch for game, you eventually find yourself one of the main North fields. This area is provides many opportunities for big game. Find a good spot at “North Fence North Field” or move to the other two locations is well worth the effort if the winds is from the North. The “Great View” is worth the effort.







## NS passage

This small corridor between the north and south sides of the ranch is a popular place for game to cross. There is water both to the East and to the South West from this spot. There are a number of obvious places to sit or stand and wait for that big buck to appear.
